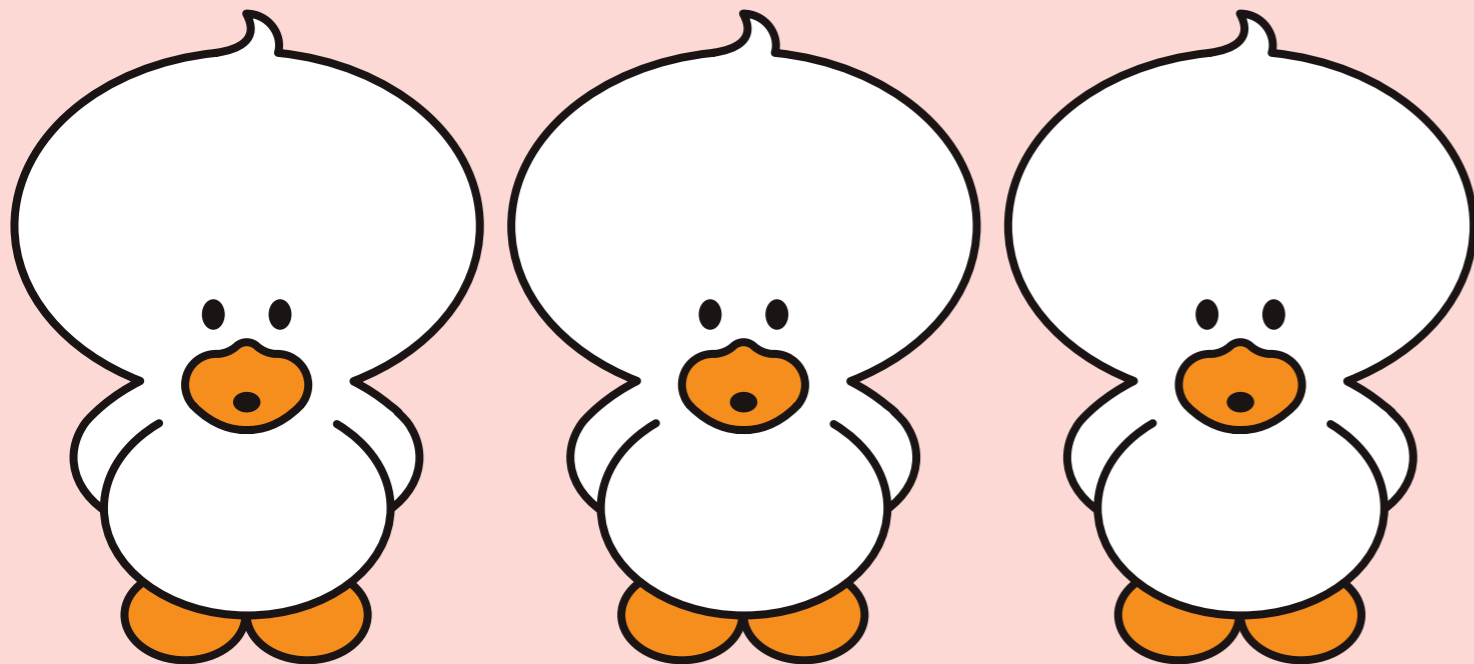
This is Nina Split.

A cute little rubber ducky.

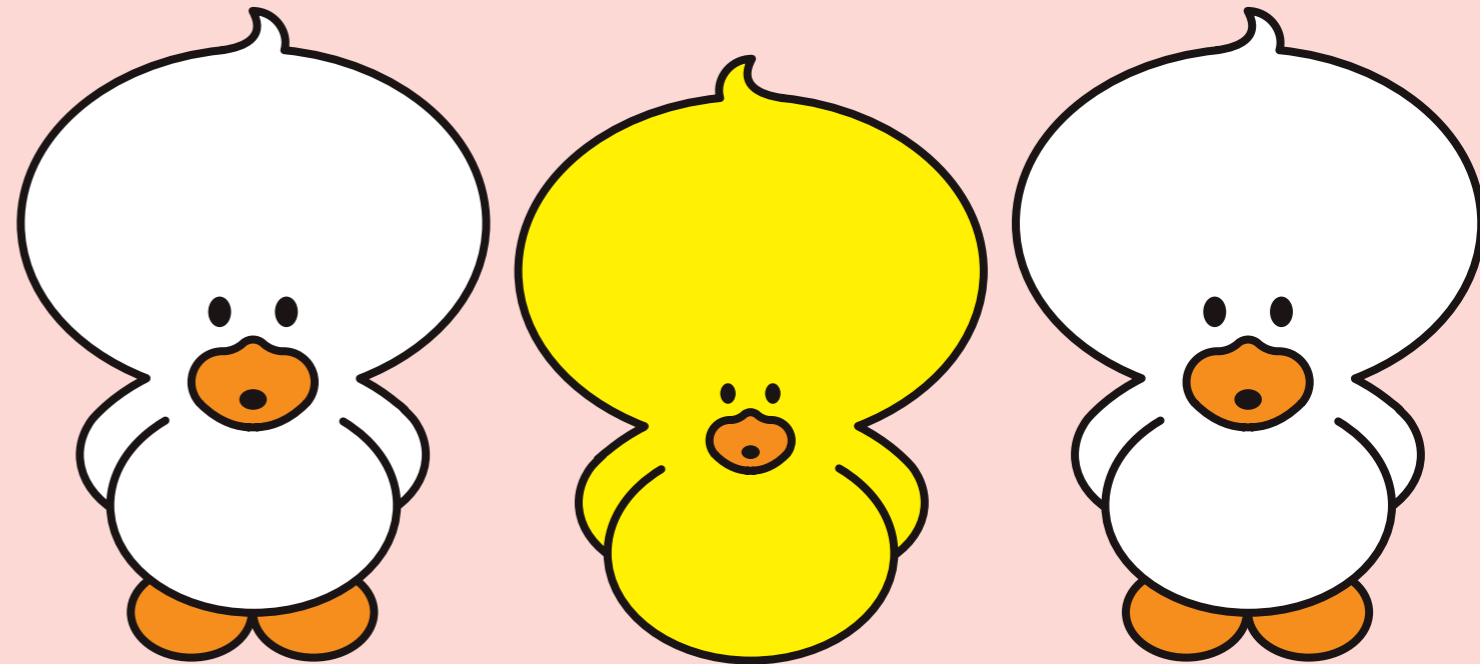
With a cute little beak,

A little lake.

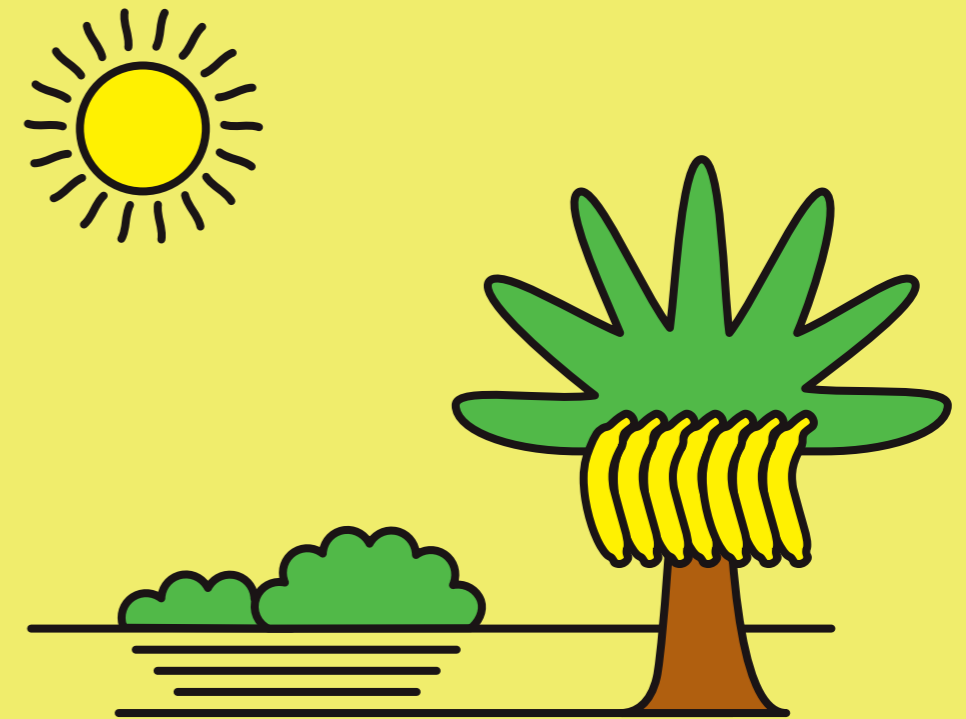
A cute little lake.

swim lots of cute little fish.

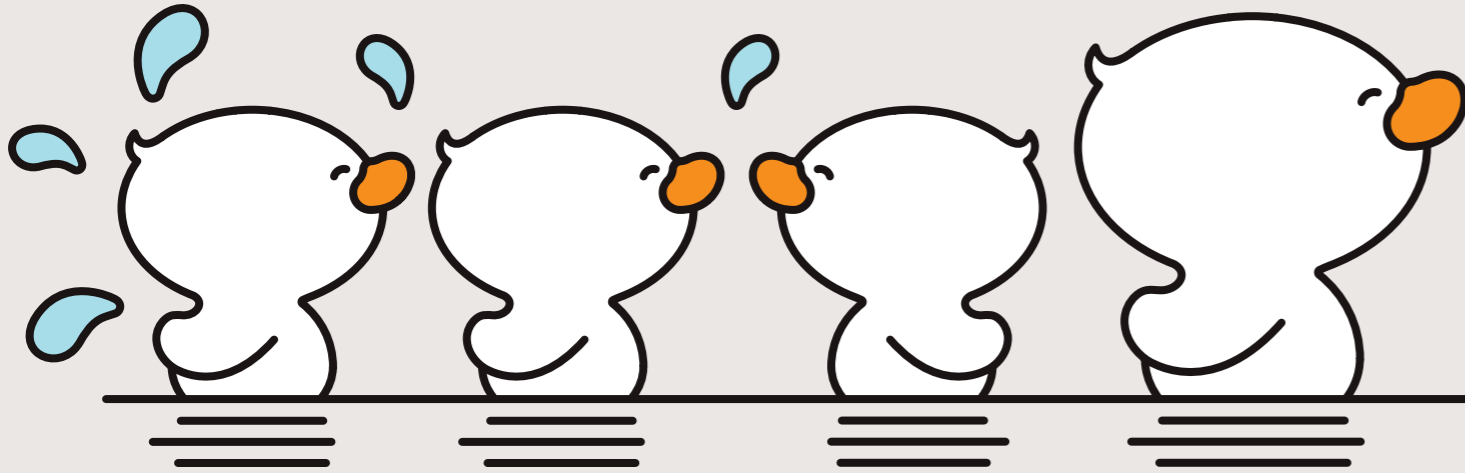


Along the shores of the cute little lake

full of yummy bananas.

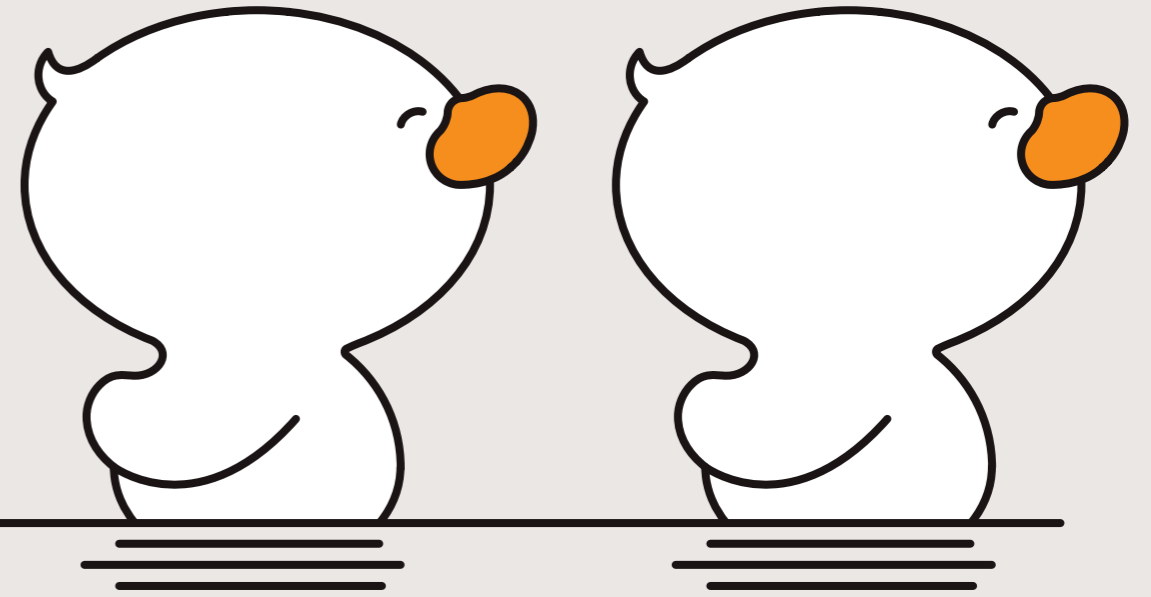
That's where the little ducks live.

Nina doesn't play along.

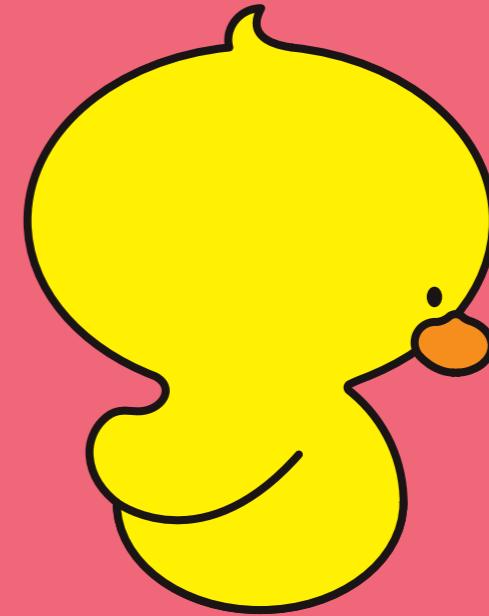
Nina doesn't swim in the long line.

Nina can't swim.

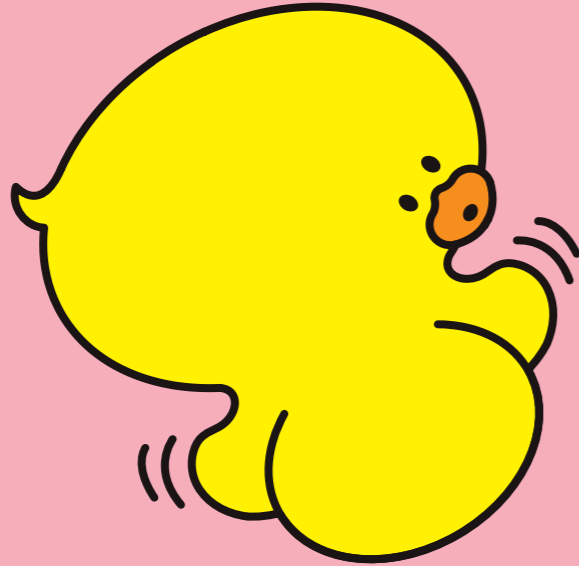
Nina is a rubber ducky.

So when they swim, they flip over!

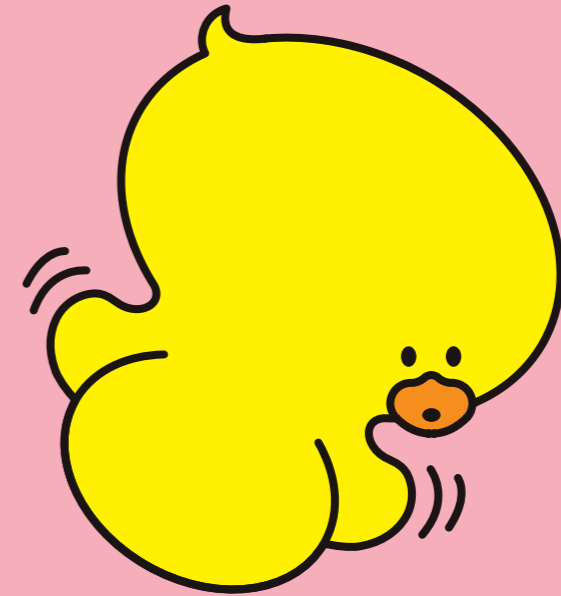


When she tries to swim,

through the water.



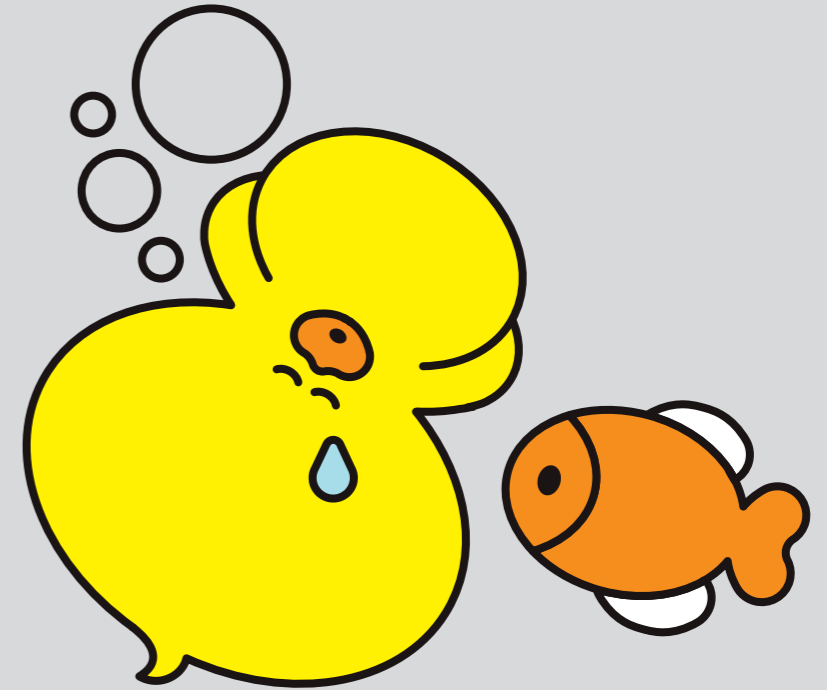
This makes her very sad.

asks a little fish who swims by.

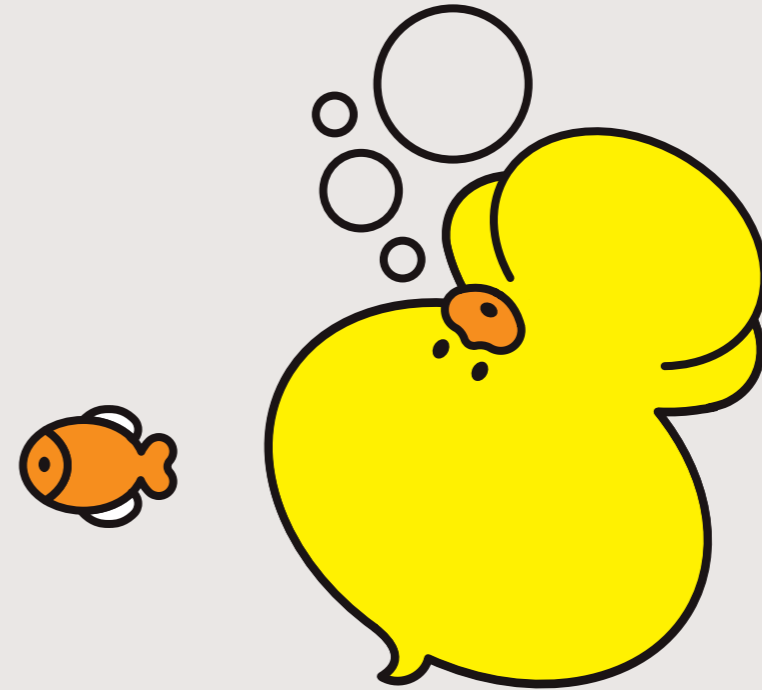
“I can’t play with the little ducks,”

and looks at the peel.

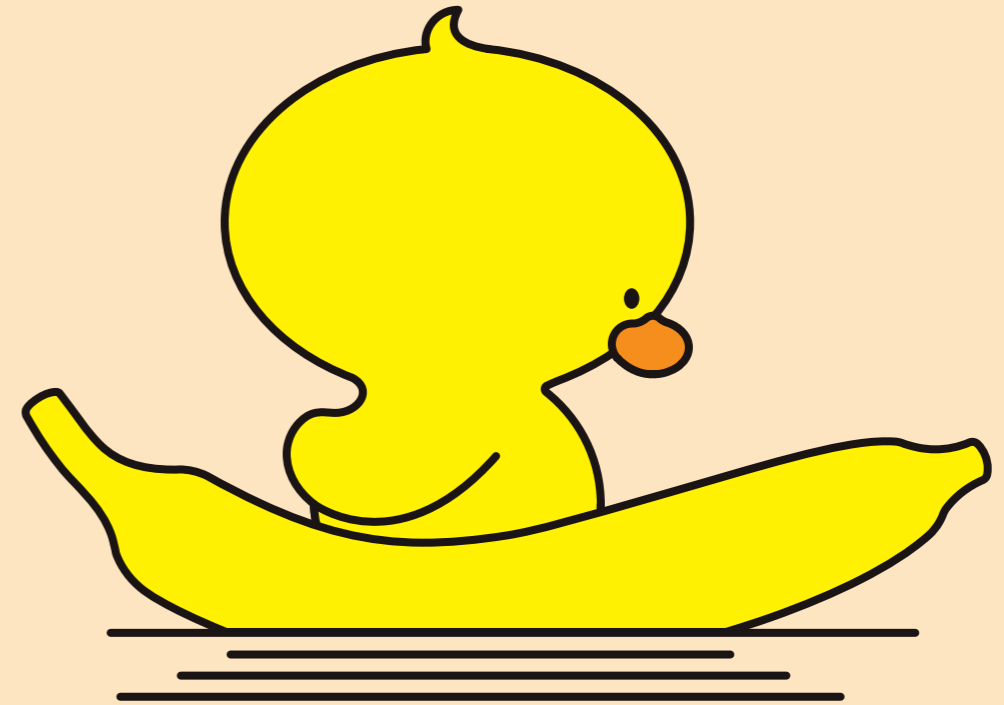
“Hm,” she thinks,

pushes off



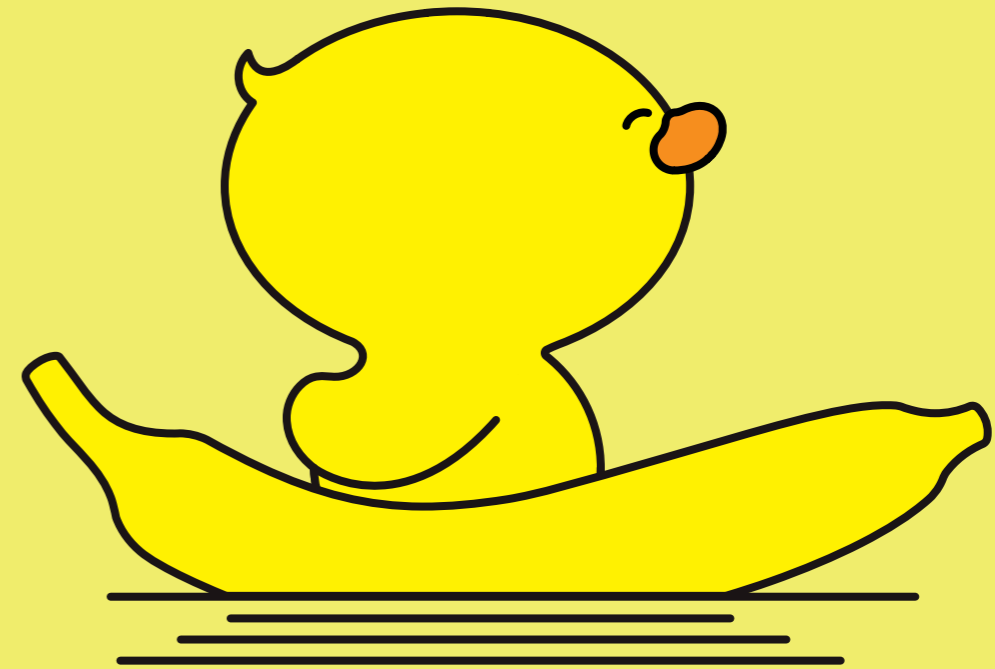
and sails onto the little lake.

“Heeeeeeey, there’s Nina!

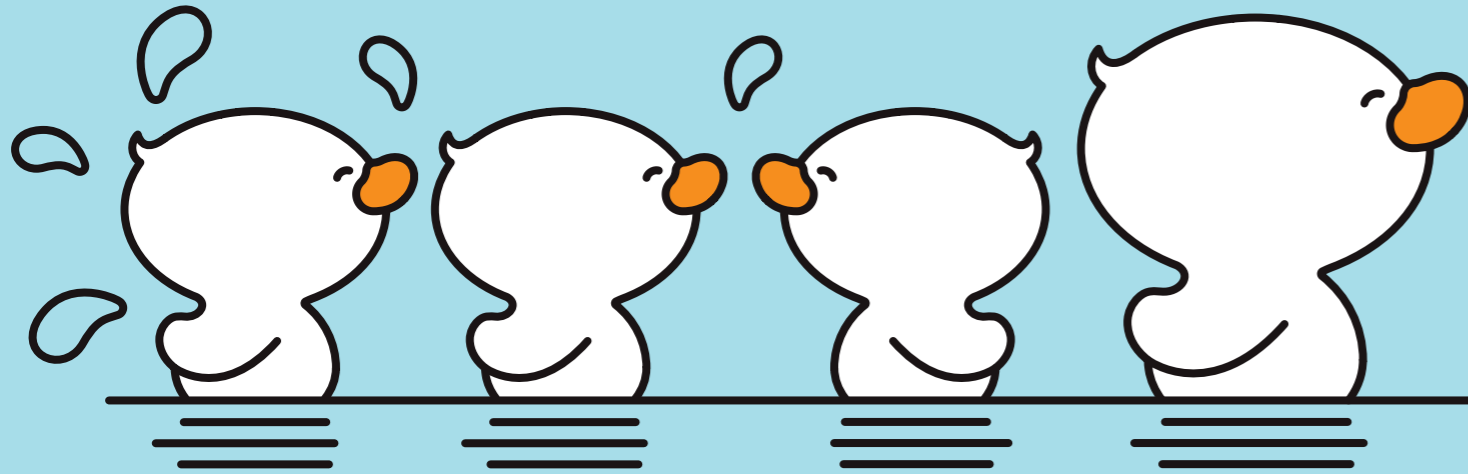
In a banana boat!”

They splish and they splash.

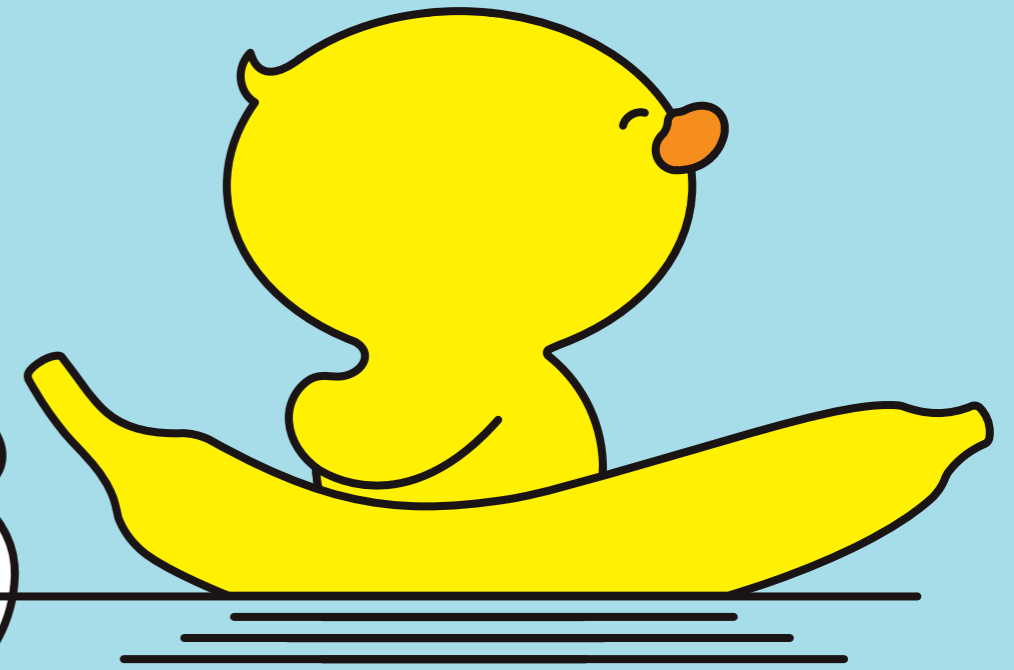


And every now and then,

with glee!

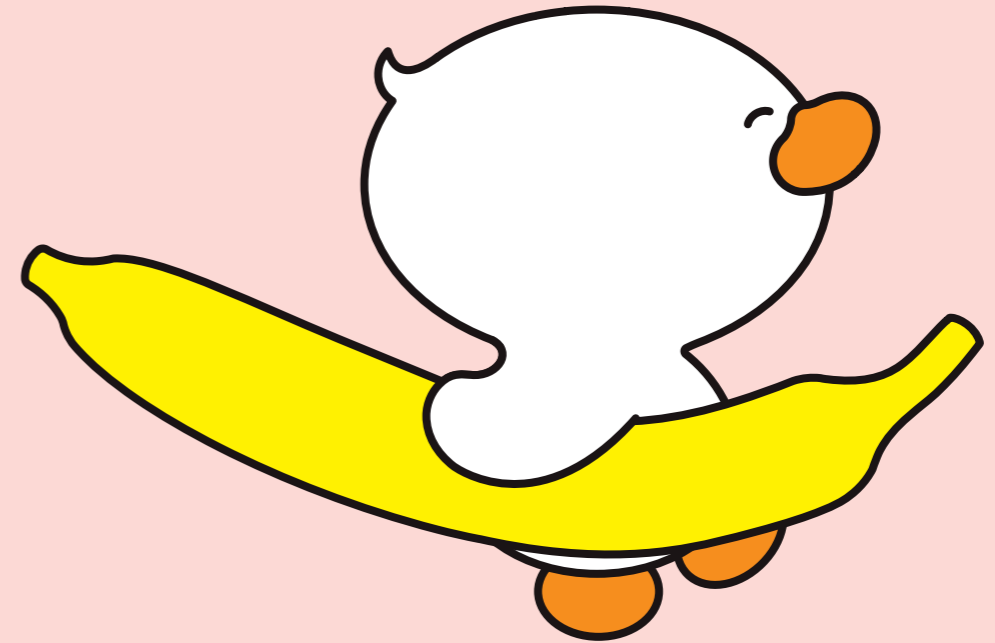

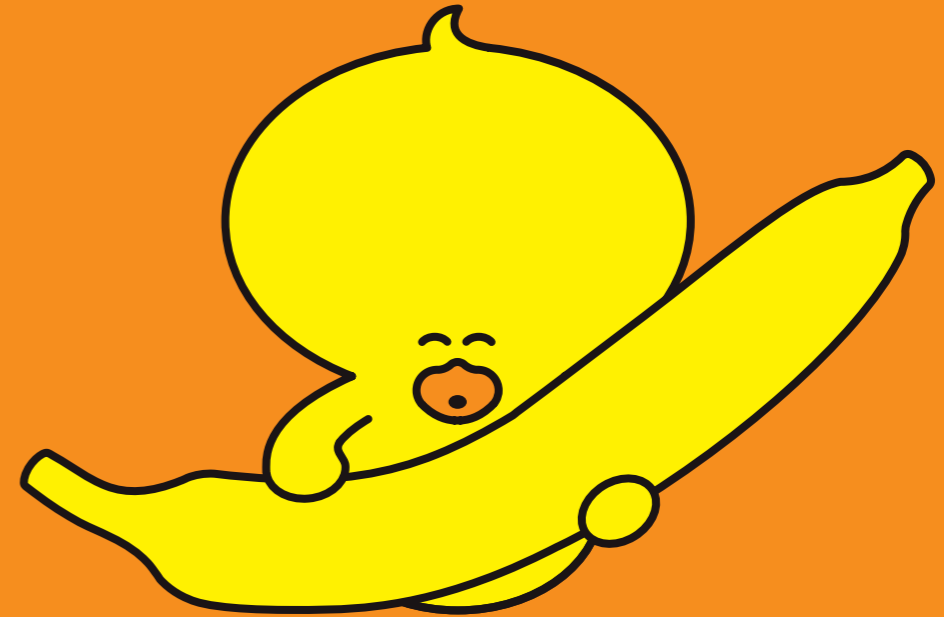
Nina plays every day.

yummy bananas...

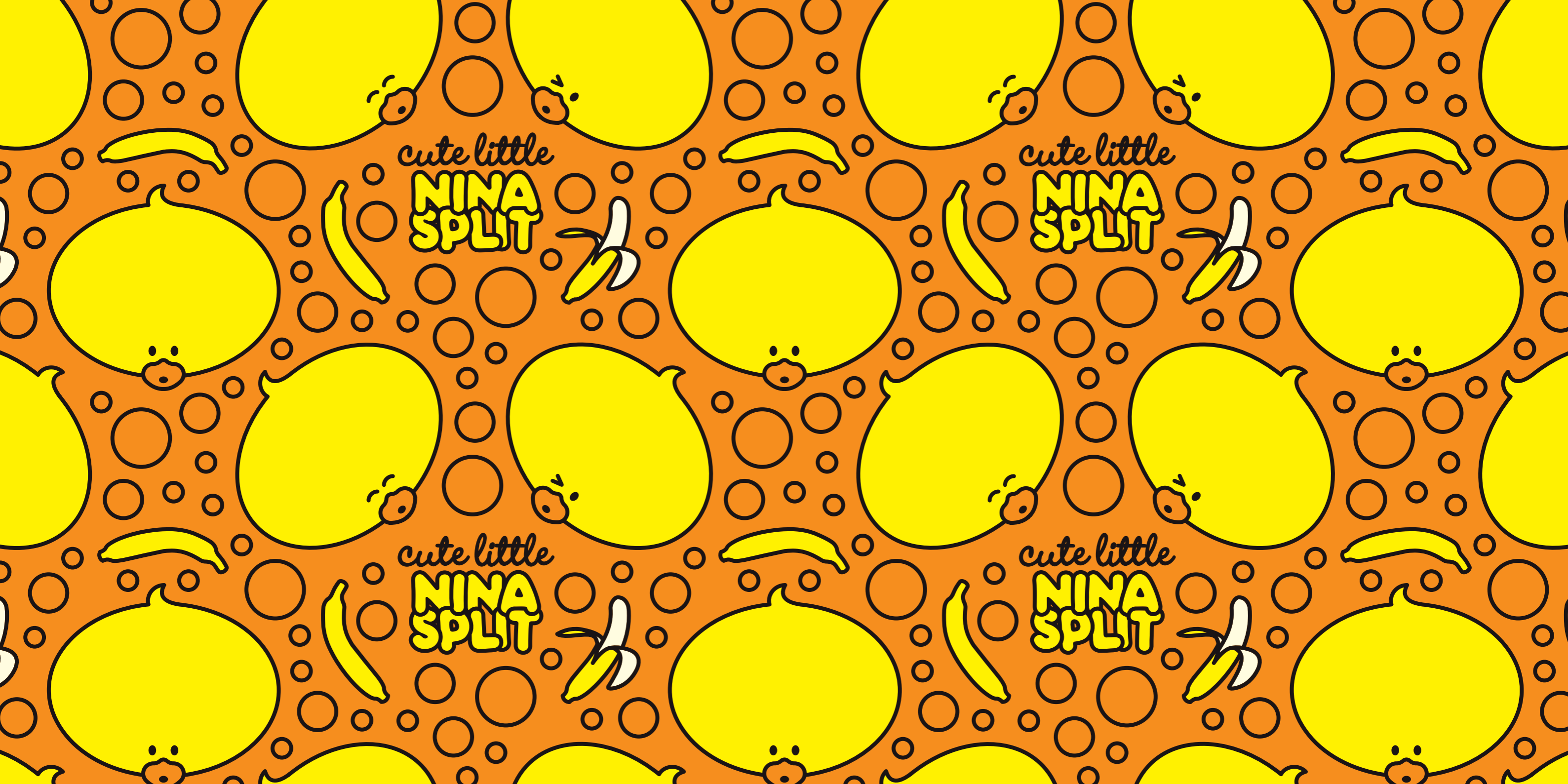
